DISTANCE EDUCATION IN UKRAINE: WEAKNESSES AND STRENGTHS

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The advent of distance education has enabled students with busy lives and limited flexibility to receive a quality education. Unlike traditional classroom learning, online learning allows you to deliver classes through a single Internet connection to students from all over the world. From 2022 to 2023, this is very important in Ukraine, since most students were forced to leave their homeland due to the armed aggression of Russia.

As for the success of distance learning, it requires support at the regional level by both administrators of higher education institutions and teachers. The main disadvantages of online learning are related to the difficulties of adaptation, lack of digital literacy, periodic technological failures. Although, despite the identified shortcomings, online learning is quite flexible and convenient. In order to properly build their educational process, students need to set strict limits for the class schedule in order to avoid absenteeism and, as a result, unsatisfactory results

But in 2022 and 2023 in Ukraine, students got the opportunity to be more flexible in completing tasks.

From personal experience, some groups of students have found new ways to be more involved in learning without the distractions and challenges they faced in class. For students, this means they are using new learning tools in forums and various online platforms. get positive things. [1] Also a very significant plus is that after reading the material from the teacher via video link, there is an opportunity to re-study the material on the student platform (Personal Learning Systems website) and get feedback from the teacher. Therefore, remote education will not do without services for videoconferencing, online meetings and distance learning for students. Platforms such as Zoom, Skype, Google meets, Microsoft Teams are convenient platforms for conducting lectures, seminars and presentations.

The disadvantage of remote education also affects the development of communication skills. An individual approach to each student is indeed an important factor in the development of information. The second of the shortcomings is the lack of motivation among students.

Most students and teachers are satisfied with the flexibility of the system and the ability to adjust the time and plans for themselves, which makes learning comfortable.

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
